

## COVID-19 Response Task Force Notice 3

## September 9, 2020

The COVID-19 Response Task Force is committed to providing the most upto-date information to the campus community regarding the impact of the coronavirus on campus. A snapshot of new cases and close contacts (at the time of this notice) is below:

- Student cases: On-campus: 24 / Off-campus: 13
- Students under observation in our \*isolation/quarantine facilities: 25 (includes students testing positive and close contacts)
- Employee cases: 4

Please continue to comply with safety measures in place to help minimize the spread of COVID-19, per the <u>CDC</u>.

- Wear a face covering/mask over the nose and mouth
- Wash or sanitize your hands and shared surfaces
- Monitor your health daily using GuideSafe
- Practice physical distancing
- Remain home if you are sick, positive for COVID-19, or have been in direct contact with an individual that has tested positive

The University's Student Health and Counseling Center, in conjunction with the State's Testing Program, has tested 476 students since the first day of classes (August 17, 2020).

\*Isolation: Individual has tested positive for COVID-19. All who test positive are asked to isolate until a negative test is received.

\*Quarantine: No symptoms but had close contact or resides on the floor in a traditional residence hall or suite with someone who tested positive for COVID-19.
